- Buses will run at regularly scheduled times. There will be study areas in study hall for those who arrive early or who must stay late to ride the bus.
- Students do not need to be present except for exams. However, if the student has more than one exam in a day, he/she must stay until all exams are completed. Students may not leave and return between exams.
- If there is a delay, the schedule will be adjusted and there will be no make-up exam time in the afternoon.
- Tri Star Juniors must attend the 5th period exam time IF they have a 5th period class at FRHS, and will NOT be required to attend Tri-Star on Wednesday (no absence). Mr. Hobbs needs to know who will still be riding the Tri-Star bus on Wednesday.
- No college or vacation days will be permitted during exams unless approved by the principal.
- Students coming into school while exams are in progress must remain in the commons until the end of the exam.
- Students with make up work (assignments, reading counts, library fines, etc.) not completed by **5/19/10** must stay for the FULL 3 exam days. Students with missing assignments must attend SH during the Make-Up Exam times for the entire week.
- If students miss their exams and are deemed unexcused, the student will receive a "0" on the exams they missed.
